GCG NATIONAL TEAM EVENTS FOR 2017-2018

National Team activities are by assignment only. Assignment to competitions may be requested by the coach of a NT athlete who wishes to represent Canada at an international competition listed on the NT Calendar of events, they must submit a request by e-mail to the WAG NTD or designate and WAG PM at least 2 months in advance. The request must indicate if participation is conditional to GCG providing funding or if participation is acceptable on a cost-shared or self-funded basis. The request is necessary whether the competition is “by invitation” or “open to NT athletes”. The coach of a NT athlete who wishes to represent Canada at a competition NOT on the Calendar must submit a request by e-mail to the WAG NTD or designate and WAG PM as soon as possible. Participation will be on a self-funded basis. This applies to competitions that are not part of the WAG NT program but are still recognized international competitions.

All other activities outside of Canada require a GCG travel authorization form which can be found on the GCG website (<http://gymcan.org/events-results/general-event-documents/authorization-forms>). Activities include, but are not limited to competitions, training camps, clinics, courses etc.

SELECTION FOR AN ASSIGNMENT

For major Games, World Championships and Continental Championships (including Pacific Rim), specific selection criteria will be distributed at least 4 months in advance. For all other National Team assignments, the NTD or designate in consultation with the WAG PM will have discretion in identifying the athletes and coaches who will compete. Such assignments will take into consideration such factors as:

- the expected level of participants and GCG’s performance objectives for the competition;
- the current health status of the athlete and her recent injury history;
- The year of birth of the gymnast, her current level of performance, and her profile as a team 2020 hopeful or a targeted gymnast (the likelihood that she will make the team for the WC or the OG and/or the likelihood that she will rank in the top 12, top 10, top 8, medal AA or an Apparatus at a WC or the OG);
- her results compared to other eligible athletes under consideration;
- her recent results at international competitions (approximately six months) and at the most recent Elite Canada, Canadian Championships, selection camp, etc;
- her consistency and stability in competitions as assessed by the NTD or designate including Elite Canada, Gymnix or Canadian Championships or in which she was assigned by GCG;
- her international competition experience or lack of, plus the type of competition she needs;
- her current status on her improvement strategies as set out between her coach and the NTD or designate.

FIG JUDGES

GCG will fund judges for World Cups, Major Games, World Championships and Continental Championships (including Pacific Rim). When possible a minimum of one judge will be funded and assigned for any NT competition and for specified NT camps. Other competitions will be on a cost shared or self-funded basis. GCG is responsible for the assignment or determination of a priority order for CS or SF events. GCG is responsible for arranging the travel for assigned judges to National Team events. Travel bookings are arranged to keep team members travelling together.

For non-National Team events, please refer to the GCG authorization form.

FIG EVENT DIRECTIVES

Directives for FIG events that are non-NT events can be found on the FIG website (<http://www.fig-gymnastics.com/site/competition/search>). Gymnastics Canada has the responsibility of approving the GCG authorization forms, assignments and completing the FIG registrations. **All communication for these events is done through GCG, unless otherwise noted.**

IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. All participants are responsible for reading the Directives for the event they are attending. If you have questions contact WAG PM: Amanda Tambakopoulos amanda@gymcan.org or Sue Ashton (program coordinator) sashton@gymcan.org
2. For all FIG Invitational's, judges are required to have a minimum Brevet IV.
3. No assignments will be given or authorizations approved to any participant with outstanding invoices owing to GCG
6. All self-funded expenses will be invoiced to the individual by GCG prior to Nominative Registration and are payable by credit card or cheque prior to departure to the event.
7. Minors who travel without a parents/guardian are required to have a Travel Consent Form.
8. All FIG events are limited to NT members or potential NT members that have been approved by the NTD or designate.
9. All gymnasts attending FIG events must be in possession of a FIG License. Note: Applications and renewals will be administrated by GCG. Gymnasts use the same FIG License card throughout their gymnastics career. Renewals are done electronically by GCG. **Non-National Team athletes are responsible for the cost of their FIG license. ALL gymnasts are responsible for lost card charges.**
11. National Team members (athletes and coaches) are required to wear the current GCG National Team uniform at official National Team activities. For all other international events they are representing their club and therefore are to wear their club uniform.
12. Funding is subject to change according to available budget and participating athletes. Funding will be confirmed prior to events with event directives.

Non-FIG invitations will be emailed to the PTO's.

PTO'S, NT Coaches & Brevet Judges are asked to email GCG if you have any questions regarding National Team Events. All other questions should go through their PTO.
