	<p>According to the Technical Regulations: Format of Novice, Junior & Senior category Day 1: All-Around & Apparatus Finals Day 2: All Around & Apparatus Finals The All-Around and apparatus ranking are determined according to the cumulative results of the two days of competition. Ranking on Vault is determined according to the HP Manual for each category – with combined score of both days.</p>

A coach who is employed on a full-time basis by an organization based outside Canada is exempted from this requirement. For 2022, the exemption request fee will be waived for a coach who is certified Competition Introduction Advanced.</p> <p>All coaches, support staff (head of delegation, chef de mission, team manager, and chaperone) and integrated support team (IST) who will participate in GymCan national competitions must have completed the following requirements.
