CLUB ELIGIBILITY	All international participants (athletes, coaches and judges) must be registered with Gymnastics Ontario and must submit Foreign Participant Registration Form 2 weeks prior to the event in order to be able to participate. PROVINCIAL ELIGIBILITY	Provincial Level Individual (2-6), RG Groups (Level 3-6), AGG Groups Provincial ODP2, Level 1 Groups, Interclub ODP1RGI1 and AGG (7 and 8) for recognition only.
COACH ELIGIBILITY	All coaches MUST be G.O. members with a minimum NCCP Level Two certification (Theory, Technical, and Practical) in Rhythmic Gymnastics. All coaches must be listed in the attached registration forms and be prepared to show proof of G.O. membership and NCCP certification on-site in order to gain access to the floor. <i>The coach listed on the registration form must not be on the list of judges for the competition.</i> The coach listed on the registration form MUST be the coach that will put the athlete or group on the floor at the competition.

	Coaches must have completed the G.O. online Risk Management course (Part A), AND must have also completed the Respect-In-Sport course (Part B), if a previous Risk Management certification has expired.

REGISTRATION DEADLINES	<p>Feb. 1, 2018</p> <p>The late fee is \$25 per athlete. No additional registrations will be accepted after Feb. 1, 2018. There will be no refunds after the registration deadline.</p> <p>The draw will take place at the Gymnastics Ontario office.</p>
APPARATUS REGULATIONS	<p>Each gymnast must bring her own replacement apparatus. If an apparatus gets stuck in the ceiling or breaks during a routine, the gymnast must use a replacement as per FIG rules and will not be allowed to repeat the routine.</p> <p>As per FIG rules, a penalty will be applied to the gymnast if anyone returns an out-of-bounds apparatus to the gymnast. The gymnast must retrieve the apparatus herself.</p>
APPARATUS MEASUREMENT	<p>As per FIG rules, the apparatus is to be measured just before the gymnast enters the competition area. Any irregularities found with the apparatus to the coach and an apparatus judge chit will be filled to be sent to the Judge Responsible after completion of the routine. The said apparatus must remain in the custody of the apparatus judge until advised by the Judge Responsible.</p> <p>If a replacement apparatus was used by the gymnast during a routine, that apparatus must also be measured.</p>
MUSIC	<p>Please upload all music ONLINE reg. system- http://rgform.eu/event.php?id_prop=534</p> <p>Deadline for music: Feb. 5, 2018</p> <p>Please bring back up music on an electronic device or CD's. . All music must be properly labeled with the gymnast's name, club name, level, apparatus, music length, title, and composer.</p>
AWARDS	<p>Medals will be awarded for first, second, and third place per apparatus and all around. Ribbons will be awarded for the fourth to eighth places. In the case of fewer than three competitors for a level, only all around medals will be awarded.</p>
SCRIPTS AND DEADLINE	<p>Scripts are required for Free routines only.</p> <p>Deadline for receipt of scripts: Feb. 5, 2018</p>
