### **Fees:**

Athletes: \$100 entry fee. Each registered participant will receive one T-shirt and one athlete banquet ticket (includes dinner & dance party).

Spectators: \$10 per day, \$15 for two days or \$20 for all 3 days (**does not include banquet**).

Children 5 and under free.

Additional banquet tickets: \$45 per ticket includes dinner and dance (each registered athlete and coach will receive one ticket included in registration fee).

Additional meal vouchers: \$45 per ticket includes lunch and dinner buffets at the Horizons Bistro located at the Coast Hotel.



## Equipment



The ceiling height clearance above the competition floor is 29 feet. There will be an FIG approved 13m by 13m floor in both the warm-up area and the competition venue.

## General Schedule

A detailed schedule will be circulated once registration is closed.

May 26th	Day 3 competition and performances. Banquet (dinner included)
May 27th	Excursions / Departure of teams.

## Awards

Medals for top three units from each category will be awarded. Details on event award criteria will be included in the confirmation package. Additional prizes may be distributed throughout the event and during the banquet.

## Transportation

## RULES

All FIG judging rules apply and will be strictly followed. Each club/country must provide a certified judge to be on the panel. Clubs unable to provide a qualified individual will be required to pay a \$250 Judging Fee.

### Ages:

<b>YOUTH</b>	8 YEARS OLD - 16 YEARS OLD
<b>AG 1</b>	9 YEARS OLD - 16 YEARS OLD
<b>AG 2</b>	10 YEARS OLD - 18 YEARS OLD
<b>JUNIOR</b>	11 YEARS OLD - 19 YEARS OLD
<b>SENIOR</b>	MINIMUM 12 YEARS OLD

### Awards:

### Insurance:

All clubs are required to show proof of liability insurance. Each club/federation is responsible for ensuring its members have the appropriate coverage against accidents, illness or injury. Any accredited person(s) who cannot provide proof of adequate insurance coverage will not be permitted to compete.

### Travel Visas:

Any Country requiring an official invitation in order to obtain a travel visa is asked to please email a request prior to April 1, 2019.

### Music:

All clubs are asked to label music as follows:

### Tariff:

All clubs are asked to label tariff sheets as follows:

Deadline to submit tariff sheets is **May 15, 2019**. Dropbox information will be distributed in the confirmation package.

**Youth Rules:**

1 Combined exercise (difficulty is calculated in accordance with FIG 11-16 Age Group rules).

2 minutes maximum duration.

**Pairs:** choose 2 balance elements from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional element from FIG tables and 2 dynamic elements from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional element from FIG tables.

\*\*OPTIONAL can be from 11-16 difficulty tables but cannot be from the same rows used for the compulsory elements.

**Groups:** choose 1 pyramid from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional pyramid from FIG tables (only 2 static holds of 3" are required in the routine) and 2 dynamic elements from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional element from FIG tables.

\*\*OPTIONAL can be from 11-16 difficulty tables but cannot be from the same rows used for the compulsory elements.

**Individual:** 3 individual elements must be executed – Category does not matter i.e. can be cat1 or cat2 (NO SALTO REQUIRED).
